



Saskatchewan Pulse Crop Development Board Don Jaques Memorial Fellowship

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Purpose:	To recognize and support outstanding academic achievement and research interest in pulse crops.
Source and Amount of Funding:	\$20,000 per year from the Saskatchewan Pulse Crop Development Board (hereafter SPCDB).
Designation of Award Committee:	<p>An appropriate Committee as determined by the Dean, College of Agriculture.</p> <p>Selection will be made from a short list of candidates prepared by a member of the Crop Development Centre representing the SPCDB.</p>
Number and Value of Awards:	<p>There will be one fellowship awarded annually valued at \$20,000. The fellowship may be renewed for a second or third year if progress in the student's research program is satisfactory.</p> <p>A second fellowship may be awarded to another student only after the first fellowship has been terminated.</p>
Program and Course Designations and Eligibility Restrictions:	<p>Open to full-time, post-graduate students in a M.Sc. or Ph.D. degree program at the University of Saskatchewan who are conducting thesis research on some aspect of pulse crop development.</p> <p>At the time of application, candidates must be either a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant. Preference will be given to Saskatchewan residents.</p>
Selection Criteria:	To be awarded on the basis of a proven record of outstanding academic achievement and research interest in pulse crops development, as determined by the Award Committee.
Renewal Criteria:	<p>Renewal of the fellowship will be based on an assessment by a faculty member familiar with the student's work (typically the supervisor). The recommendation of the faculty member will be given to the Award Committee, who will make final renewal decisions.</p> <p>The Award Committee must notify the Saskatchewan Pulse Crop Development Board of all renewal decisions by August 1 each year.</p>
